When to use this form

This form should be used to notify the BMFA that you will be holding a public display that includes model flying activity in order that the additional insurance cover can be activated and confirmed. The form should be used for any event where members of the public will be in attendance whether they are paying visitors or not.

It is not necessary to complete the form for events that are entirely club member based or where only suitably insured model flyers will be attending such as "fly-ins".

Please complete the form as accurately as possible, if you are unclear on any areas then contact the BMFA office for assistance, you will be contacted once we have received the form only if there are any areas that require further information or if there are areas of concern.

You will receive a letter confirming the extended insurance cover for your event usually within seven days of returning the completed form.


