Terms and Conditions of Trading

1. Access will not be allowed onto the airfield before 5:30 pm on Friday 23rd August.
2. You must vacate the trade area no later than 6:00 pm on Monday 26th August.
3. Particular attention must be paid to litter. All traders are responsible for clearing litter in their area. Skips will be provided close to the trade area. If these become full, please contact a BMFA official who will be able to advise of alternative skips with sufficient capacity. Otherwise all litter must be taken away with you. Strict adherence to this requirement is essential if we are to retain use of the airfield for future years. **Traders failing to clear away their litter will be invoiced for cleaning charges.**
4. There must be no sub-letting of trader stand space.
5. Illegal or unfair trading will result in expulsion from the airfield, and forfeiture of all monies paid. All radio control models/equipment for sale must be on frequencies which are legal for use within the UK.
6. Traders must carry adequate third party insurance and/or other appropriate insurances.
7. A condition of our use of the airfield requires BMFA to provide an indemnity to the DLA, and we similarly require an indemnity from you against any claim which may arise from your trading activities.
8. All dogs must be kept under control and on a lead at all times and any mess they produce must be cleared up and disposed of.
9. The same driving rules apply to the airfield as to the public highway, so all persons must wear seat belts when travelling in cars and crash helmets when riding motorcycles. Vehicles must be road legal and insured. If you are not allowed to drive on the road, you are not allowed to drive on the airfield. The airfield speed limit is 20 mph. Please keep well below this when in the trade area.
10. Please remove the crystals/modules from any transmitters for sale on your stand, to avoid the risk of your customers switching on and causing interference to competition or trade flying. All other transmitters must be immobilised when not flying on the airshow line.
11. Demonstration flying of trade models is limited to the Showline line and is by prior arrangement with the CD.
12. No flying will take place on 27 MHz.
13. **Passes will be issued for each person wishing to gain entry to the site. Anyone wishing to gain entry without a pass will be charged £30, refundable on production of a valid pass.**
