## **5. Club Requests for Area Funding.**

### **a) Education Program funding request**

The Western Area Education Officer thanked the Western Area for their support and said he had £77.00 in funding remaining from last year. It had been a very active year involving more and more young people, this had shown the need to refine the items purchased for durability and ease of use. A request for £300 from the Western Area funds to ensure that we have the equipment and models available to meet the increased commitment and continue to give young people the opportunity to experience model flying.

A proposal to agree the £300.00 was made by BRCMAC and seconded by Wessex MFC.

### **b) Wessex MFC STEM funding request**

The Area Education Officer gave a review of the STEM day that the Wessex MFC in conjunction with Lavington school ran in 2017. It was a very successful day thanks to the funding support from the BMFA Western Area. This funding request is to run a second event in 2018 at an envisaged cost of £226.87.

A proposal to agree £230.00 was made by Beaufort MFC and seconded by Wessex MFC.

### **c) Beaufort MFC Engineering show funding support request.**

The Beaufort MFC delegate explained the request for Area support they had submitted. The Beaufort club incur costs in manning a show over 3 days including set up. The Beaufort MFC was one of the key exhibits and the only one showing Model flying and promoting the BMFA.

A proposal to agree the £380.00 was made by Beaufort MAC and seconded by Woodspring Wings.
